Conduct in-depth research in substantive areas of work specific to the office (energy, environment, sustainable development including MDGs etc)

Driver/Clerk (GS-3)

Carries out driving assignments as well as basic administrative and clerical support to the office.

Fluency in English and Korean (both oral and written) is required for all positions.
