Test Operation of Happy Bus...Cheering Bus Drivers when Pushing the Alight Bell



A pleasant voice of cheering for the bus driver resonates when you push the bus bell. It is somewhat embarrassing for the person who pushes the bell, but soon a slight smile spreads across the face.

Since August 7, 2017 Incheon has begun the "Happy Bus Day", in which voices of cheering for the bus drivers flow out when the alight bell is pushed. When the passenger pushes the bell to get off the bus, cheering messages such as "You're the best! Cheer up!", "Keep it up! Super power!", etc. resonates. Its purpose is to cheer up the bus drivers who are suffering from a heavy workload. A total of 156 citizens living in Incheon including elementary school students, foreigners, etc. participated in recording the cheering messages.

Currently, two Incheon No. 8 intra-city buses and two No. 511 buses are using the Happy Bus service. The city has designed this project to deliver messages of support by citizens to bus drivers who experience difficulties due to long hours of driving. The decision whether to expand the implementation of the service will be made after approximately two months of test operation.

Promoting the Introduction of Twenty Low-Floor Electric Buses

In an effort to create a low-carbon clean city, Incheon is promoting the plan for introducing twenty low-floor electric buses in the first half of next year.

The price of electric buses is relatively high (460 million won per bus), but it is considered an eco-friendly transport means as it produces less carbon dioxide and noise than internal-combustion buses. Incheon plans to purchase electric buses when replacing decrepit buses of over ten years.

The Implementation Plan for the Development of Handeul Area Is Approved

Incheon has approved the implementation of urban development project for the Handeul Area, Seo-gu District. Handeul Area Project is a private urban development project for creating a residential area of 4,871 households in 3,567,000㎡ land of 170, Baekseok-dong, Seo-gu with a budget of 19.3 billion won.

According to execution plan, Handeul Area is comprised of 42.8% of residential site, 51.5% of infrastructure site such as parks, green, parking lots, etc., 4.4% of commercial site, and 1.3% for other facilities. The project is planned to begin in 2018, and be completed in 2021.
