'Incheon KTX' to open in 2021

The outline of the operation plan for KTX departing from Incheon, whose construction is about to begin, has revealed itself. According to the Incheon KTX's strategy and environmental impact assessment report released by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, and Transport on September 6, the train will make 24 round trips every day, operating 12 times with 20 cars, 12 times with 10 cars. It will be operating at the speed of 120 km/h from Songdo Station to Eocheon Station on the Suwon–Incheon line. Meanwhile, the Incheon KTX project aims to connect Songdo Station with various parts of the country, such as Busan and Gwangju by 2021 by laying a 3.5 km–long railroad between Eocheon Station and Gyeongbu KTX Line.

KTX · GTX running in Incheon

As our city's project to expand rail networks proceeds smoothly step by step, the KTX will be available in Incheon and the GTX will make the commute from Incheon to Seoul more convenient.

First of all, as for the Incheon KTX project, the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, and Transport has recently completed its strategy and environmental impact assessment and confirmed the operation schedule. The KTX will run 24 times daily between Songdo Station on the Suwon–Incheon line to the destinations, such as Busan and Gwangju, operating 12 times with 20 cars, and other 12 times with 10 cars. It will take 2 hours and 42 minutes for Busan and 1 hour and 47 minutes for Gwangju. It is set to open in 2021.

As the Line B project (GTX), which will make the section between Songdo and Seoul Station a thirty-minute distance, has been selected as a subject of the Ministry of Strategy and Finance's second-half preliminary feasibility study, now expectations are raised about the project's feasibility. Operating at 100km/h through a tunnel located 50m below ground, the GTX is able to run from Songdo to Seoul Station in just 26 minutes. The GTX Line B, which is set to open in 2025, will be built on the 80km–long line ranging from Songdo, Yeouido, Yongsan, Seoul Station, Cheongnyangni, and all the way to Maseok in Namyangju.

Sightseeing Hovercraft



For the first time in Korea, a sightseeing hovercraft will crisscross the coastal waters of Incheon.

Our city has introduced 5 hovercrafts to promote sightseeing in Incheon islands and is planning to put the boats into operation starting from next holiday season. The hovercrafts are designed for sea excursions and include 2 six-seaters and 3 ten-seaters. Capable of freely running around even the coastal waters of Incheon, which have a large tidal range, the vehicles are expected to greatly improve visitor's access to nearby islands.
