Together Day Commemorative Event



- ♦ The 11th Together Day Commemorative event in 2018 co-hosted by Incheon Metropolitan City and Incheon Immigration Office is established on **May 20th 2018 (Sun), from 10:30 to 15:00, at Incheon Grand Park, Eoul Keun Madang (Large Yard).**

- ♦ This event is intended to provide the venue for the citizens of Incheon, along with their foreign neighbors, to overcome cultural differences, create the society where every culture is respected, communicate and harmonize with each other.

- ♦ The order of event will be: **Part 1 Pre-ceremony Event (Cheerleaders and drums), Part 2 Ceremony** (Opening Ceremony, Guest Introduction, Celebratory Speech, Awarding), Fruit Performance and **Bubble Show** as an intermission, and **Part 3 Celebrating Performance**, which will be consisted of the celebratory performances from 5 foreigner teams and T-Broad Broadcasting Service (Singer Yun Tae-gyun). For additional events, sales booths, police horseback riding for children and painting contests for elementary school students will take place.

- ♦ It is expected that the Together Day Event will contribute to the development of local society, social integration and cultivation of the global civic awareness in the aspect of the entire world through encouraging the citizens and foreign residents of Incheon to respect each other and create harmonious society together in the era of accelerated globalization.

Establishing MOU in Health and Medical Treatment with Almaty, Kazakhstan



- ♦ Incheon Metropolitan City successfully established an MOU for exchange cooperation in the areas of health and medical treatment with Almaty, Kazakhstan (Mayor Bauyizhan Baibek) on April 19th.

- ♦ Kazakhstan is the 4th in the rank in terms of the number of medical tourists to Incheon, following China, Russia and U.S. Although Almaty is the old capital of Kazakhstan and is a hosting city of Kazakhstan International Tourism Fair (KITF), it did not particularly have any mutual exchanges with Incheon.

- ♦ Through establishing the MOU with the health authority of Almaty for exchanges in medical human resources and health care policies between the two countries (cities), Incheon Metropolitan City successfully established the foundation for the enhancement of the friendship and mutual exchanges between the two cities.

Bimodal Tram, the Advanced Means of Transportation, to be Operated for the First Time in Korea in Cheongna



- ♦ On April 21st, Incheon Transit Corporation introduced and began the operation of Bimodal Tram, as a means of GRT transportation, in Cheongna International City.

- ♦ Besides the current 14 GRT non-step buses (No. 701 & 702; Cheongna Int'l City Station to Gajeong Station), 4 additional bimodal trams will be introduced. The number of daily operations will be increased from 79 to 99, and the time for the last train will be pushed back from 00:25 to 00:30, as well.

w Fees are the same as the Green Buses, which is 950 won for transportation cards and 1,000 won for cash, which are cheaper than the intra-city buses. Transfer benefits are available, as well.
