# The first implementation of a complete-free school uniform and school lunch ever in Korea

Incheon Metropolitan City will provide free school uniforms to all the freshmen of middle and high schools and free school lunch even to the children in the private kindergartens from next year for the first time in Korea.

Incheon Metropolitan City, Incheon Metropolitan City Office of Education and Incheon Metropolitan City Association of County and District Mayors have signed on the "Education Special City Incheon Joint Declaration to Establish Educational Autonomy and Local Autonomous Cooperative Relationship" on September 18, 2018. The joint declaration states that the parties will cooperate for free education from daycare centers & kindergartens to high schools, safe and reliable education, and equal education in which opportunities are equal and results are righteous.

According to the joint declaration, in the following year 2019, expenses of purchasing school uniforms will be supported to approximately 52,000 freshmen of the middle and high schools. The support amount will be KRW 301,000 per student residing in the Incheon Metropolitan City. The budget of KRW 15.7billion will be borne by Incheon Metropolitan City(including districts and counties) and Incheon Metropolitan City Office of Education taking half share respectively. Incheon is the very first city among the 17cities and provinces in Korea that has implemented a complete free school uniform policy for all the freshmen of middle and high schools.

The free school lunch, which has been carried out to the children in daycare centers, will be further expanded to private kindergartens for about 32,000children aged 3~5. In addition, the unit price of the lunch will be raised by 5~8% in order to improve the quality. In particular, the Incheon Metropolitan City Office of Education will participate in the project to support the difference caused by the eco-friendly agricultural products in order to reduce the school parents' share in the expenses up to zero percent.

Mayor Park Nam-chun of Incheon Metropolitan City said, "In order to make Incheon as an education specialized city, I will do my best to create the best environment in Korea good enough to raise children, in cooperation with the Office of Education, City Council, Counties and Districts." Superintendent of Incheon Metropolitan City Office of Education said, "With the policies of free school lunch and free school uniform, Incheon Metropolitan City will be evaluated as self-governing organization leading the free education."




Giving out transparent umbrellas for free to children Incheon Metropolitan City has been distributing transparent umbrellas for the students visiting the city hall and in the first grade of elementary school since September in order to ensure the traffic safety of the elementary school children in the rain.

The children visiting the city hall can receive the transparent umbrellas after taking a safety education for the traffic safety police officer held in the conference room on the 2nd floor. For the first graders of elementary school, the umbrellas will be delivered when the schools apply for the traffic safety education to the competent police station and a police office visits the school for providing such education.

The umbrella was designed to have a reflective bias tape edge and handle all in yellow so that it could be seen well enough to the drivers. The city characters Beomi, Aini and Kkomi are printed on the umbrella.

## Expansion of influenza vaccination from 6 months to 12 years old children

Incheon Metropolitan City expands the age of the target children for the free influenza vaccination. The influenza vaccination has been made for the children aged 6 months to 59 months in the city, but it will be expanded to the children aged 6 months to 12 years. According to the expansion of the age for the free influenza vaccination, the targets are the children who were born in Jan. 1, 2006 to Aug. 31, 2018, including those who go to daycare centers, kindergartens and elementary schools.

Meanwhile, as of Aug.30 this year, there are 514 designated medical institutions for the influenza vaccination for children, and the free vaccination is available anywhere in the country regardless of their addresses.
