Incheon metropolitan city is selected as a beneficiary of the 'Support Project of creating Region-based Contents Business Fostering Center' conducted by Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism in 2019 where five metropolitan cities and provinces participated in, for the first time among

Incheon metropolitan city plans to spend 80 million Won to create a second Children Forest Experience Center next to Incheon Grand Park's bike square and open it within this month. The 30,000-square-meter Children Forest Experience Center consists of Saecom-dalkom Forest where you can

municipalities in the capital area. The Region-based Contents Business Fostering Center will be established on 9 -11th floor of Bupyeong Tech City Building located near Gilsan station, Bupyeong-gu. Inside the center, there will be 30 offices, three meeting rooms, an open studio and a shelter for workers, etc. A total of 9.9 billion won will be spent on building the center and operating the initial program, including 4.8 billion won from state budget and 5.1 billion won borne by the local government. The center plans to create corporate fostering fund worth of 10 billion Won and create a global network in related fields in order to foster a knowledge-based, high value-added contents industry.

Opening of Lake House Facilities in Cheongna Lake Park

On April 25th, the Authority of Incheon Free Economic Zone (IFEZ) opened some facilities of Lake House in Cheongna Lake Park, a landmark of the Cheongna district. A few facilities were opened on the day including the observatory deck located on the 1st and 2nd floors. Actual operation is scheduled for June, 2019 after inviting public earlier this month to select business operators such as water leisure shops and cafeteria. The first floor of Lake House will be a ticket booth and a waiting room for water leisure sports such as water taxi and canoeing, and the second floor will be an observatory deck and cafeteria, which will provide a whole view of the Cheongna Lake Park.

Electric Bus will begin operation in Incheon ...supplying 120 Vehicles by 2022.

Eco-friendly electric buses of Incheon city began operation on April 12th. The city first placed 10 electric buses on the No. 721 city bus route, which runs from the Gajwa-dong garage in Seo-gu to the Namdong middle school. The newly deployed electric bus is a large bus equipped with 44 seats, with an authorized driving distance of 178.2 kilometers after a single charge. It is expected to provide more pleasant ride as there is no emissions and less noise during driving or stopping as it uses an electric motor.

Residents Reporting System on illegal parking will be enforced starting this month.

Starting this month, Incheon city will implement a 'Residents Reporting System on Illegal Parking' that allows fines to be levied without checking the site.

There are four targets of the reporting system: Vehicles parked 5 meters around the fire hydrant, those parked 5 meters from the corner of the intersection, those parked within 10 meters of the bus stop, and stationary vehicles that violated the stop line of the crosswalk. The fine is 80,000 won for vehicles parked around the hydrant and 40,000 won for the rest. If you want to report illegal parking, you can submit two or more photos that are taken at intervals of more than one minute from the same location by using 'Safety e-Report' app camera of the Ministry of Public Administration and Security.
