- (1) Local or overseas residents 18 years or older
(At the opening of the Games / born before 9 May 1999)
- (2) Available for at least 3 weeks as volunteers.
- (3) Preferred qualifications
 - Available before the World Cup
 - Has experience volunteering at international, cultural or sporting events, international volunteer corps, etc.
 - Able to communicate in foreign language(s)
 - Has license or certificate for certain positions

(1) Competitions

The volunteers will help organize pre-game team meetings, participate in the preparation of the locker rooms and sports equipment at the stadiums and training site.

(2) Medical Service

The volunteers who relate with medical and doping control will be working at the tournament host venues. In order to assist them, medical administrators will be recruited from volunteers.

(3) Accreditation

The volunteers at the accreditation centres will print and issue personal accreditation cards to all participants in the preparation and staging of the World Cup.

(4) Media

The volunteers of this function will see how the journalist work and will be able to support them in stadium media centres, tribunes, photo positions, press conference rooms, and mixed zones at the stadium

(5) Marketing

The volunteers will be assisting the implementation of the sponsors' marketing programmes and guest catering service projects at the stadiums. They will help decorate the key venues of the World Cup, and assist with navigation around venues.

(6) Guest Management & Translation

The volunteers will assist VIP guest hospitality at the stadiums, as well as at the welcome desks at official FIFA hotels to provide interpreting services. They will also assist in the organization of simultaneous translation service at the stadiums and the international broadcasting centre to perform urgent written translation if required.

(7) Transportation

The volunteers will help organize transportation and assist in the arrivals/departures areas.

(8) General Service

The volunteers will help set up the volunteer centre at the venue and assist volunteer check-in volunteers at the tournament venues. Their other task will assist sustaining the smooth operation of the food and beverage concessions.

(9) Spectator Support

The volunteers at the stadiums will manage the visitor and provide any information they needed, and direct spectators to their seats at the stadium.

(10) Environment

The volunteers will clean up the stadium and promote the environment campaign.

(11) Traffic Control

The volunteers will direct traffic and manage the parking lot.

(12) Airports

The volunteers will be welcoming the guests at the airports

Guideline for Application form

Step 1 : Personal data(①~⑥)

This is the beginning of your application process.

From now on we will be able to know you a little bit more and know why you want to volunteer for the FIFA U-20 World Cup Korea 2017.

Step 2 : Contact Information(⑦~⑧)

⑦ : Contact Details(address, phone number, email, etc)

- Notification, news, announcement, etc are sent by email. Please check your email on a regular basis.
- A mobile number is compulsory. Please input your mobile.

Step 3 : Availability and Preference(⑨~⑬)

⑩ : Preferred Role

KLOC will assign volunteers according to the candidates' preference. Please select preferred occupation. According to the fulfillment of preferential requirement(s) and application status, preferred occupation may not be reflected.

⑪ : Available Period for Volunteer, Preferred Area and Occupation, etc

The FIFA U-20 World Cup Korea 2017 will be held between May 10 and June 11 in 2017. The period is over 3 weeks for the event. KLOC will preferentially select volunteers who are willing to work for long time.

⑬ : Work availability before the event

Volunteering period is expected to be more than 3 weeks (21 days) for World Cup Games including pre-Games(preparation), Draw period and day offs.

You can participate for Pre-Games or for whole period. Volunteer who can participate in longer period will be pre-selected.

Step 4 : Previous volunteer experience(⑭~⑰)

If you have had any previous experience, whether in social, religious, small or large events, please describe them.

If the FIFA U-20 World Cup Korea 2017 is your first opportunity, it will certainly be a unique experience.

Step 5 : Language Skills(⑱~⑳)

We recruit volunteers with various language skills such as Korean, English, French and so on. Please select the language and the level you speak. It is mandatory to select both English and Korean.

If you are unfamiliar with Korean, please select 'level1' and continue your application.

Step 6 : License / Certificate(㉑~㉔)

If you have any knowledge of professional background on medical/nursery skills or Driving skills, fill out the form.

Step 7 : Introduce(㉕)

Please, provide further details to describe yourself.

Timeline

Milestones of the Volunteer Programme

- **Recruitment (starts 1 November to 15 December 2016)**

Recruitment is open to everyone, regardless of gender, ethnics and physical ability. There is only one requirement: volunteers wishing to work at the FIFA U-20 World Cup Korea 2017 must be at least 18 years old by 8 March 2017

- **Selection (begins in December 2016 to January 2017)**

Potential volunteers undergo the screening process of two steps: an evaluation of application form and an interview. Those who successfully pass the screening process will proceed to the training phase.

- **Training (begins February 2017)**

The main objective of training, organised at each of the 6 host cities, is to assist future volunteers in developing necessary skills. As a result, they will learn more in February 2017. Participants will also learn about the specifics of the chosen functional area and engage in venue training at the World Cup facilities.

- **Tournament support**

This event will require over 1,200 volunteers. They will be assigned to their tasks ahead of time to make sure the venues are ready for the guests: FIFA U-20 World Cup Korea 2017 volunteers will begin 10 May 2017; volunteers for the official draw will begin 8 March 2017.
